The vendor is responsible for providing all of their equipment, tent, and supplies for their display.
The Corn Boil is not responsible to provide any vendor any item or items needed for their display.

Not For Profit booth registration fee is \$20.00 for a 3 day commitment
A booth for Saturday and Sunday is a requirement. Friday is optional but included in the price.

Registrations will be accepted until July 1 or as space allows.
Corn Boil Sponsors at the Gold and higher levels receive Free Booth space.
No refunds will be made after June 15th unless the show is canceled.
